Sign Post Program

Put a permanent mark on one of the NIMBA trails in 2011!

The Northern Indiana Mountain Bike Association (NIMBA) Sign Post Program will allow your business to permanently show your support for outdoor recreation in the Michiana area. We will be installing signs on the new Bendix Woods trail and resigning the Rum Village and TK Lawless trails. The same type of high quality sign posts that we installed at Potato Creek State Park will be used for the 2011 sign program. For \$35 we will place your business name on a sign at the trail of your choice. Your businesses name will be at the bottom of the printed portion of the sign, protected by high impact plastic. There will only be one name per sign post, and we will send you a picture of your sign along with its location on the trail. Would you like your business name on multiple signs or multiple trails? Just send in \$35 for each sign.

Our mountain bike trails are heavily used throughout the biking season by riders, hikers and runners. Your support helps NIMBA ensure that all our trails are well signed and simple to navigate.

Your \$35 funds the installation of the signpost; it does not cover any future maintenance or replacement.

Sign Post Program

The Northern Indiana Mountain Bike Association is a not for profit, all volunteer group, dedicated to the maintenance and expansion of mountain bike trails in Northern Indiana and Southern Michigan.

The Bendix Woods trail is located in the historic Bendix Woods County Park, 14 miles west of South Bend Indiana. This is the newest trail built by NIMBA, with the first portion of the trail opened in 2011.

The Rum Village trail is located in the city of South Bend. Rum Village is known as one of the more versatile trails in the region, offering fun for both the beginner and advanced riders. South Bend is recognized by the League of American Bicyclists as Bike Friendly Community, in part due to opportunities for a variety of cycling options in the metropolitan area.

The TK Lawless trail is located 30 miles northeast of South Bend in TK Lawless County Park. The trail is renowned in the region for it's fast challenging flow.
